Pre Requisites:

- All applicants must provide certificates showing completion of ICS 100-400 as well as NIMS 700a and 800b
- All applicant must show a certificate for Presentation Skills training such as Method of Instruction (MOI), Type 2 Fire instructor, FEMA G265 Basic Instructional Skills course or similar training.
- **Note:** NJOEM has a 4-Day G265 course on the schedule for June 10, 11, 17 and 18. Class size is limited so sign up right away if you need this prerequisite.
- All applicants must show proof of teaching at least one ICS 200 class. (agenda showing their name as instructor and date of course)

Course Purpose:

This 2-day course prepares participants to deliver the Emergency Management Institute's (EMI) ICS 300 curricula. (ICS for Expanding Incidents). Participants are expected to be advanced practitioners of the Incident Command System. The course will focus on how to deliver the course and NOT the ICS system itself. Participants are expected to know the ICS 300 material before taking this course.

Course Objectives

At the end of the course, participants should be able to:

- Know the FEMA requirements for delivering ICS 300 in the field
- Demonstrate the ability to present ICS 300 material in front of the class
- Demonstrate an understanding of ICS 300 unit exercise material by presenting exercise material in front of the class
- Pass the existing ICS 300 test

Target Audience

The target audience for this course is Emergency Response personnel who have advanced knowledge of the Incident Command System, are experienced instructors, have experience using the Incident Command System as part of their response duties, have served in a Command and General Staff position in the field and will be training emergency responders on the ICS 300 material..**Classsize limited to 10.**
